 1916S LEGALIZE BOXING
 Rejected 48.5%
 The Montana Athletic League sought again to legalize boxing as in the 1913 Kiley Law that voters repealed by referendum in 1914. A state athletic commission would license and regulate boxing matches. As in the 1914 referendum, Butte, Helena and Mineral County voters favored legalization, those in Billings and Great Falls were narrowly divided and Ravalli, Lincoln, Granite and Flathead county voters were opposed. But legalization gained supporters in 1916, particularly in northeastern counties.
