An Act to Authorize the State of Montana to Become Indebted in the Sum of Three Million Dollars in Excess of the Constitutional Limitation of Indebtedness and Over and Above Any Bonded Indebtedness Heretofore Incurred or Created and for Which the State of Montana Is Now Obligated, for the Construction, Repair, and Equipment of Necessary Buildings, Other Permanent Improvements and the Acquisition of Necessary Grounds Therefor, at the Several Institutions of the State of Montana, Consisting of the State University at Missoula, State College of Agricultural and Mechanic Arts at Bozeman, the Montana State School of Mines, at Butte, the Montana State Normal College at Dillon, the Eastern Montana State Normal School at Billings, and the Northern Montana Agricultural and Manual Training School at Fort Assinniboine, Now Comprised in the University of Montana, and the State Orphans' Home at Twin Bridges, Montana School for Deaf and Blind at Boulder, the Montana State Industrial School at Miles City, the State Vocational School for Girls at Helena, the State Insane Asylum at Warm Springs, the Montana State Tuberculosis Sanitarium at Galen, the State Soldiers' Home at Columbia Falls, and the State Prison at Deer Lodge; Providing for the Issuance of Bonds in the Name of the State of Montana as Evidence of Such Indebtedness and for the Sale Thereof, Prescribing the Form of Such Bonds and Providing for the Levy of an Annual Tax Sufficient to Pay the Principal Thereof and the Interest Accruing Thereon.

SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 268.

Chapter 126.

An Act to Authorize the State of Montana to Become Indebted in the Sum of Three Million Dollars in Excess of the Constitutional Limitation of Indebtedness and Over and Above Any Bonded Indebtedness Heretofore Incurred or Created and for Which the State of Montana Is Now Obligated, for the Construction, Repair, and Equipment of Necessary Buildings, Other Permanent Improvements and the Acquisition of Necessary Grounds Therefor, at the Several Institutions of the State of Montana, Consisting of the State University at Missoula, State College of Agricultural and Mechanic Arts at Bozeman, the Montana State School of Mines, at Butte, the Montana State Normal College at Dillon, the Eastern Montana State Normal School at Billings, and the Northern Montana Agricultural and Manual Training School at Fort Assinniboine, Now Comprised in the University of Montana, and the State Orphans' Home at Twin Bridges, Montana School for Deaf and Blind at Boulder, the Montana State Industrial School at Miles City, the State Vocational School for Girls at Helena, the State Insane Asylum at Warm Springs, the Montana State Tuberculosis Sanitarium at Galen, the State Soldiers' Home at Columbia Falls, and the State Prison at Deer Lodge; Providing for the Issuance of Bonds in the Name of the State of Montana as Evidence of Such Indebtedness and for the Sale Thereof, Prescribing the Form of Such Bonds and Providing for the Levy of an Annual Tax Sufficient to Pay the Principal Thereof and the Interest Accruing Thereon.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Montana:

Section 1. That the Legislative Assembly of the State of Montana is hereby authorized and empowered to direct the State Board of Examiners to issue bonds in the name of the State of Montana in an amount not exceeding Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in excess of the constitutional limitation of indebtedness and over and above any bonded indebtedness heretofore incurred or created and for which the State of Montana is now obligated, the money derived from the sale of said bonds to be used for the purpose of constructing, repairing, and equipping necessary buildings, for other permanent improvements, and for acquiring necessary grounds therefor, at the several institutions of the State of Montana, and consisting of the State University at Missoula, the State College of Agricultural and Mechanic Arts at Bozeman, the Montana State School of Mines at Butte, the Montana State Normal School at Dillon, the Eastern Montana State Normal School at Billings, and the Northern Montana Agricultural and Manual Training School at Fort Assinniboine, now comprised in the University of Montana, and the State Orphans' Home at Twin Bridges, the Montana School for Deaf and Blind at Boulder, the Montana State Industrial School at Miles City, the State Vocational School for Girls at Helena, the State Insane Asylum at Warm Springs, the Montana State Tuberculosis Sanitarium at Galen, the State Soldiers' Home at Columbia Falls, and the State Prison at Deer Lodge.
