and repair of facilities and for land acquisition at the Warm Springs asylum for the insane. A one-half mill general property levy was authorized to service the debt.

As in 1912 when the facility was initially funded, home-county voters supported the measure by about 95 percent and those in neighboring counties and urban centers approved it by margins of about three-to-two. Voters in the southeastern corner of the state opposed the funding, as in 1912. But Lewis & Clark and Sweet Grass counties, originally opposed, now gave strong support to the bond issue.

19403 \$950,000 BOZEMAN (MSCI) BONDS

Rejected 47.6%

44.0% voted, 51,921 for and 57,137 against

This petitioned initiative proposed \$950,000 in 20-year bonds to be serviced by a one-fourth mill general property tax for construction, repair and equipment of a library and science facilities at Montana State College in Bozeman. This was the first ballot issue to offer benefits to a single unit of the university system. Gallatin County voters were most enthusiastic, giving it two-to-one support. Seven other western counties and Yellowstone also cast majority votes for the bonds. But across the rest of the state opposition was proportioned generally to distance from Bozeman.
