

Quick Reference Sheet on How to Search for Historical Administrative Rule Versions (for versions from 2007 to Current)

- Navigate to the Administrative Rules website at rules.mt.gov
- Once the searched rule has been found, it will appear on the screen in a document viewer where the rule content can be viewed, printed, and downloaded.



Additional information can be found within the sidebar on to the right of the document viewer.



• To view a historical version of an administrative rule, click the drop-down caret and select from the list of versions that are available (note: you will not see the drop-down caret if there is not a version prior to the current rule).



• After selecting a historical version there will be a banner across the top of the document viewer indicating you are looking at a past version.
